Little Scholars is for students entering kindergarten, first, or second grade during the 2022-2023 school year. Students will participate in FUN, engaging activities as they visit four different themes. The kindergarten themes include Diving into the Deep Blue Sea, Down on the Farm, a Safari in the Savanna, and the Wild World of Dinosaurs.

First Grade themes include Blasting Off into Space, Diving into the Deep Blue Sea, Into the Great Outdoors, and Over in the Rainforest.

Second grade themes will include a trip around the world to Ancient Egypt, Australia, China, and Mexico. Each week, students will rotate to a new theme. During each theme, students will focus on academic standards that will build the foundation students need to be successful in school. Little Scholars will be providing activities in reading, vocabulary, writing, and math. Science and social studies will be integrated through hands-on and engaging activities. The program will have a strong emphasis on phonics, sight words, and early numeracy.

Skills taught during this program will be based on the Georgia Standards of Excellence, giving students a head start for the 2022-2023 school year. Meals and modified transportation will be provided.
